Albany boasts the convenience of a major city while being surrounded by natural environment, including four spectacular National Parks - pristine coastline, mountains and bush.


The City has thriving unique local businesses complimented by popular retail chains. York Street is the main shopping area and takes in views of the beautiful Princess Royal Harbour.

# Training Support

Pioneer Health Albany is very focused on providing a safe, supportive working environment for all registrars undertaking training in the practice. The practice has supported a number of doctors to complete their DRANZCOG and DRANZCOG Advanced qualifications during their stay in Albany, providing supervision, mentoring and practice wide care and support.

We currently have two senior GP Obstetricians who provide 24 hour 7 days a week support to our GPO registrars. Our obstetric team is supported by a Practice Midwife, dedicated nurses and an administrative team that meet weekly to review patients and hand over any necessary care information. Albany has two resident specialist Obstetrician/Gynaecologists who provide support when required.

The practice prides itself on providing a flexible work environment, recognising the after hours demands of obstetric work and accommodating changes to a doctor's schedule to meet their individual needs. In relation to registrar training, Pioneer Health understands the importance of balancing the obstetric workload with general practice to ensure an optimal training experience and exam preparation occurs.

## Future Services

The practice is currently planning an extension to our facility that will enable us to have a dedicated obstetric wing. This extension is hoped to be completed throughout 2019.

We are also investigating the establishment of a midwife clinic, that will allow our obstetric patients to see our specialised midwife for routine appointments. These clinics will provide an increased level of practice support to our GP obstetricians, sharing the care of routine pregnancies and improving balance for the GPO team.
